

ERCA

Family Camp: Ages 0-18, accompanied by an adult. Each participant must register! \$80/person, max \$300/ family.

Beginner Camp: Grades 2-3. A 3 day, 2 night introduction to camp. \$150.

Senior Retreat: Ages 55+. You're never too old for church camp! \$165.


All grades indicate grade completed in the 2023-2024 school year. All prices indicate early bird. After May 6, all prices are \$25 more.
